Travel plays an essential role in stimulating economic growth, cultivating vibrant communities, creating quality job opportunities and inspiring new businesses, and it is indispensable to our nation's global competitiveness.

Travel is a significant economic driver for **Maine**—and matters to our communities, jobs and public funding.

IN 2022

- Domestic and international travelers spent an estimated **\$5.8 billion while visiting Maine**.
- Travel spending was 16.8% above 2019 levels and 23.5% above 2021.

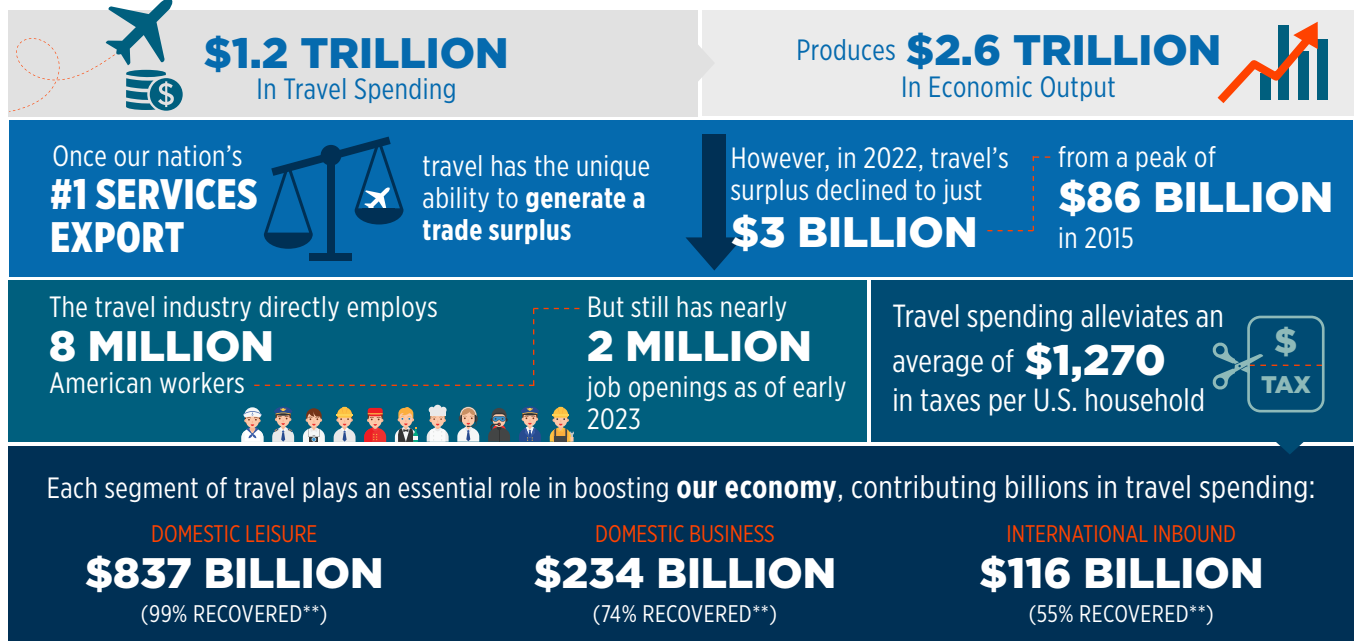
The travel industry **fuels businesses, jobs and investment beyond travel**—creating a ripple effect within our communities, including **Maine**.

IN 2019

- Travel spending directly **supported 36,600 jobs**, and was the **state's 4th largest sector in terms of employment**.
- Travel spending **generated \$330 million in taxes to state and local governments**.
- Rather than taxing constituents, travel brings money into our communities, which helps fund public programs such as police, firefighters, teachers, road improvements and community revitalization projects.
